CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter consists of two sections which are conclusion and suggestion. The conclusion is obtained based on the analysis of the research questions that are stated in chapter one. Then, this study gives the suggestion to provide information for academic readers especially the next researchers who want to conduct the similar study or to continue this study.

5.1 Conclusion

From the data analysis, it is concluded that this study found the five Deixis they are Person Deixis, Time Deixis, Place Deixis, Discourse Deixis and Social Deixis. Beside that, the references found in this study are in Person Deixis are "I, We, Us, Our, Me, and My" as First Person Deixis. "You, Yourself, and Yours" as Second Person Deixis. "He, She, Its, They, Them, Him, His" as Third Person Deixis. Time Deixis found are "Of 2017, Every Minute, A year, Since, Today, A long time ago, This weekend, Tomorrow, Now, Last year, A few years ago, 35 years ago, Next season, 2018, Four times, 10th, Right now, Started, At the beginning, Five years, In four, To every new, Sometimes, Once, Twice, Last week, Three and 2 half years and 98 years old, Going to, Will, am feeling, Become and Know". Then, Place Deixis found are "There, That, Right here, Here, This, On the Earth, Came out, Into the world, Go home, Go back, Go down, Came, Going down and Go out". Discourse Deixis found are "This, That, Those, These", and the last, Social Deixis found are "Almighty God, President Jerry Falwell, CFO and Vice President, Am your President, Your, You, Your God,

God, President, President of the United States, Our moms, Your family, We are brown, black or white and Vice President Mike Pence".

Based on the results of the study that the most dominant Deixis appeared in the speech "Never, Ever, Give Up" by Donald Trump are as follows: Person Deixis is used 447 times (46.90%), Time Deixis is 71 times (7.45%), Place Deixis is 137 times (14.38%) Social Deixis is used 189 times (19.38%) and Discourse Deixis 109 times (11.44%) So it is very clear that the dominant types used by Donald Trump in this speech are Person Deixis with frequency 447 times (46.90%) especially the use of the word Deixis "You" in Second Person Deixis with the highest frequency of 129 times, Deixis "I" of 71 times in First Person Deixis and "It" of 51 times in Third Person Deixis. The type of Deixis that has the lowest usage in the speech "Never, Ever, Give Up" by Donald Trump is Deixis Time where the total frequency is only 71 times.

5.2 Suggestion

For students majoring in English department, especially those who like to watch speeches from influential figures, it is recommended that they must understand and learn the importance of deixis, because it can help to keep away from misinterpretation of the speaker and receiver. Thus, it can help them to understand the contents of speech more easily. The researcher also whishes that there will be mentors or tutors for other researchers in Deixis aspect. The researcher also hopes that the lecturers may give more explanation about Deixis and its function in the utterance of spoken language. This study may give the lecturers or the teachers an inspiration to design creative strategy in teaching

Deixis. It will be the guidance for the teachers to make a media for teaching English especially about Deixis so that the students will not bored when they learn deixis. And the last one is after doing research on Deixis in Donald Trump's Speech, it is suggested that there are researchers who research about Deixis in this speech by focusing on only one type of Deixis, for example Discourse Deixis, or doing research on Deixis but using other research objects such as journals, novels, films and so on. It is also hoped that using other theories so as to add references to Deixis.
